

White oiled ash

Coat must never be placed next to a heat source, and should always avoid extended exposure to sunlight. For cleaning, use lukewarm water on a wringed clean cloth for cleaning, always without the use of chemicals.

The wood might change color over time. Coat is made of white ash treated with oil and can easily be refreshed by using a white oil in order to retain the naturally warm sheen of the wood. Oil treated wood is soil repellent. To avoid the wood from drying out Coat should be oiled regularly.

Black lacquered ash

Coat must never be placed next to a heat source, and should always avoid extended exposure to sunlight. For cleaning, use lukewarm water on a wringed clean cloth for cleaning, always without the use of chemicals.

Coat in black ash is stained and lacquered and demands no further treatment.

Ring

The solid aluminum ring has been polished. The solid black steel ring has been oxidized to give it the satin look. The rings should only be polished with a wringed clean cloth with lukewarm water
