







A light minimalist side table that complements the Angel stool. The bearing structure, made of steel rods, is visible through the tempered glass top making the table light and elegant. The tabletop is neatly integrated into the metal structure to produce a seamless piece.


FRAME	Galvanized steel
TABLETOP	Glass
FEET	HDPE (polyethylene)

Recyccling instructions

If the feet are attached to the frame - remove these. The tabletop is lifted from the frame.

The materials are sorted and recycled using the instructions at the recycling facility.

A minimalist and expressive coat rack made of six poles held by a metal ring. Coat can be hung with the notch facing inwards or outwards – as you prefer. Coat is easy to dismantle to store and to then unfold again to be placed wherever you need it.


WOOD	Ash
PLASTIC RING	POM
METAL RING	Aluminium, steel or brass
PINOL SCREWS	Galvanized steel

Recyccling instructions

Lift the metal ring upwards to remove it. Unscrew the pinol screws in the POM ring. Remove the POM ring

The materials are sorted and recycled using the instructions at the recycling facility.

Cuba is a functional stool inspired by Cuban lifestyle and culture, and whose wooden details are the result of highly advanced Scandinavian manufacturing techniques. The stool comes in three different heights – and in oiled oak or black lacquered oak. The seat can be upholstered from a large choice of leathers or textiles.

SEAT FOAM	Galvanized steel
SEAT PLATE	Plywood
LEGS & SEAT	Oak
FEET	HDPE (polyethylene)
FOOT SUPPORT	Powder coated steel

Recyccling instructions


Remove the upholstered seat plate by removing the bolts underneath the seat (the seat can be replaced, please contact Møbel for more info).

Unscrew the bolts and remove the washers from the legs.

Remove the foot support from the legs by turning the legs.

Remove the plastic feet from the legs. These can be wiggled out using a screwdriver.

The materials are sorted and recycled using the instructions at the recycling facility.



Description

The "Font" collection is a family of chairs, lounge chairs, barstools and sofas – available with or without armrests. The name of the collection refers to graphic fonts that inspire the variating thickness of the cushion and backrest.

Overview of materials

The table below shows the different materials used for production of a Font chair or sofa.

FRAME Stainless steel

FRAMEFEET	HDPE (Polyethylene)
FOAM	CMHR (Polyurathane)
SEAT BASE	FSC certified plywood
UPHOLSTERY	Depends on choice

Recyccling instructions

Unscrew the backrest from the frame, using the screws under the backrest.

Unscrew the seat from the frame, using the screws underneath the seat.


Use a scissor or knife to cut open the upholstry, and pull it off the seat and backrest.

The foam can now be easily pulled from the metal frame of the backrest, and the plywood of the seat. The materials are sorted and recycled using the instructions at the recycling facility.

CERAMIC TABLE	Glazed ceramic (not recyclable)

Unscrew the pinol screw from the leg.
Remove the feet from the legs.
